



**PROJECT:** Creation of a Regional Network of Andean Maternal-Perinatal Health Centers

**DESCRIPTION**

The project was funded by the Italian Cooperation. Its main objective was the improvement of maternal and perinatal health service in a geographical area including Peru, Bolivia and Ecuador.

GISMAP activities concerned the geographical location of selected hospitals and then the harmonization, homogenization and representation as thematic maps of the health data collected by the single hospitals. Data included the present situation about human resources and available infrastructures in health sector, rates and causes of perinatal mortality, and vaccination rates by type.

The final product was a cartographic atlas both in hardcopy and digital format.
