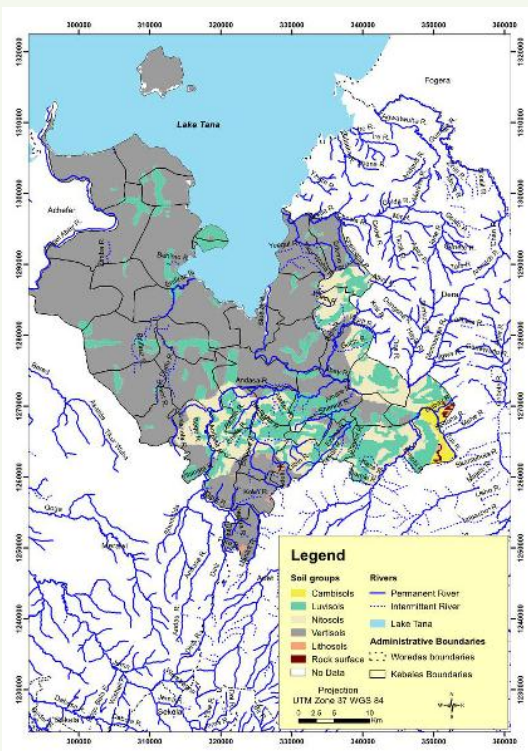

DESCRIPTION

SupHort Project was implemented by CIHEAM in four woredas of Ethiopia. Its main objective was the development of horticulture. Main activities included supporting horticultural productivity and market linkages of small-holders farm, providing training to farmers and establishing Farmers-Research-Extension Groups, developing small scale irrigation systems and providing regional authorities with tools for supporting agricultural services planning for horticultural sector development.



GISMAP collaborated with SupHort Project in the production of GIS tools aimed to provide orientation and recommendations for future development of horticulture.

In collaboration with local GIS consultants, data about land use, horticultural productivity, existing and potential water sources for irrigation, soils, climate, markets, facilities and infrastructures were collected through local authorities and in the field.

GISMAP provided then the technical assistance in data processing for the identification of most suitable areas for further development of horticultural production, as well as in the preparation of thematic map and of other dissemination tools.
